Please have all the LISD paperwork/online forms completed so we don't get behind for the upcoming season. #### **SWAY Concussion Baseline Testing/Formerly Impact Testing**

The two systems do not communicate with each other and our trainers will login onto the SWAY system to check the status and manually flip the status in Rankone to complete.
